

Warm weather information.

We have all been struggling in the heat this week and students have responded remarkably well to the challenge so far. As the week has become increasingly hot we have taken the following measures:

- Students have been advised to leave jumpers at home and to wear shirts without ties - polo shirts or blouses.
- Water has been provided during the hottest times of the day in classrooms.
- PE activities have been organized to take account of the conditions. Students are walking in the shade or doing shorter periods of activity.
- Students have been advised to wear sunscreen if they are outside
- Sensible hats may be worn at break and lunchtimes during this spell
- The hall is a cool shady place at break and lunchtimes and there are corridor and indoor areas that are cool.
- There are sheltered areas outside for students to sit.
- Students are being advised not to play games for long periods at break and lunchtimes.
- Staff are being asked to be vigilant about students who appear to be suffering from the heat and to act appropriately.

This weather is expected to continue for the rest of this week and we shall be back to normal uniform and procedures next week.
